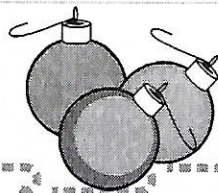




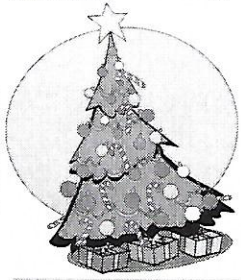
Dear Ms. Christine,
